Purchase Notice Following Confirmation of Discontinuance Order**

the use of land specified in that order or imposing conditions on the continuance of that use
or requiring the alteration or removal of buildings or works specified in that order, or
requiring the discontinuance of the use of the land for development consisting of the winning
and working of minerals or imposing conditions on the continuance of that use or that any
buildings or works on the land so used should be altered or removed or that any plant or
machinery used for the winning and working of minerals should be altered or removed.

I/we hereby serve notice, under section 137 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990,
on the Council and I/we claim that—

- (a) by reason of the order the above-mentioned land is incapable of reasonably beneficial use in its existing state; and
- (b) it cannot be rendered capable of reasonably beneficial use by the carrying out of any development for which planning permission has been granted, whether by the order or otherwise;

and I/we hereby require the Council to purchase my/our interest in the said land, namely the freehold/leasehold (terms and rent payable attached).
