Definitive Map Modification Order 2007

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order(s) has/have been submitted to the Secretary of State for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order(s).

The **start date** for the above Order(s) is **18 June 2008**

Consideration of the Order(s) will take the form of a local public inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at The Guest Hall, The Priory Centre, The Priory, St Neots, Cambridgeshire on 11th November 2008 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by deleting from them that part of public footpath No11 St Neots shown running from the eastern end of Almond Road St Neots in an easterly then north-easterly direction to Ordnance Survey Grid Reference TL 1915 6091 at the eastern end of public footpath No11A St Neots, as shown on the Order map.

Any person wishing to view the statements of case and other documents relating to this Order may do so by appointment at the County Council's main office during office hours.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and proofs of evidence

Within 8 weeks of the start date 13 August 2008

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant and any other person who has made a representation.

Within 14 weeks of the start date 24 September 2008

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving them the Secretary of State will send copies to the Authority, the applicant, every other person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has made a representation (excluding copies of any supporting documents).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a copy to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has made a representation (excluding copies of any supporting documents).

4 weeks before the date of the inquiry 15 October 2008

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving them, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

- i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case;
- ii) the applicant's proof of evidence to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case; and
- iii) all other proofs of evidence to the Authority and the applicant.

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case and proofs of evidence are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
