

NOTICE OF ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Doncaster Borough Council
Public Footpath No.7 Auckley (Part) and
Public Footpath No.1 Austerfield (Part)
Diversion Order 2007

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **29 April 2008**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a hearing.

The Hearing will be held at **Auckley Community Centre, Main Street, Auckley, Doncaster** on **Wednesday 27 August 2008** at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to stop up the public footpath No 7 Auckley, commencing at its junction with the roundabout at Grid Reference SK 647797 99052 (point A) and running in a southerly direction for approximately 350 metres to the parish boundary and then continuing as Footpath No 1 Austerfield for 220 metres to the southern boundary of Hurst wood at grid reference SK 64746 98540 (point B) and create an alternative footpath to a line running from the junction with the roundabout at grid reference SK 647797 99052 (point A) and proceeding in a generally south east direction for a distance of approximately 460 metres to the road crossing at Grid Reference SK 65142 98806 (point D) and then travelling in a south west direction for approximately 290 metres to the parish boundary continuing as footpath no 1 Austerfield for approximately 190 metres to Grid Reference SK 64942 98384 (point C) and then in a north west direction for approximately 250 metres to the junction with the existing footpath at Grid reference SK 64746 98540 (point B).

Timetable for sending in statements of case

Within 8 weeks of the start date 24 June 2008

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has made a representation.

Within 12 weeks of the start date 22 July 2008

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Hearing must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving them the Secretary of State will send copies to the Authority, the applicant, every other person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has made a representation (excluding copies of any supporting documents).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a copy to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has made a representation (excluding copies of any supporting documents).

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
