

NOTICE OF ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Doncaster Borough Council
Public Footpath No. 13 Hatfield
Modification Order 2007

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **31 December 2007**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a local public inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at **Hatfield Woodhouse Village Hall, off Main Street, Hatfield Woodhouse, Doncaster** on **Tuesday 20 May 2008** at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the footpath on land east of St Lawrence Churchyard, Hatfield from the kissing gate in the wall of the churchyard (grid reference SE6634 0961, point A) and proceeding in a north easterly direction for 35 metres to a point where it rejoins the alternative branch of Public Footpath No 13, Hatfield (grid reference SE6636 0963, point B). The footpath will have a width of 1.4 metres.

Any person wishing to view the statements of case and other documents relating to this Order may do so by appointment (i) at the Central Library, Waterdale, Doncaster during normal working hours; (ii) at the Hatfield Library, High Street, Hatfield, Doncaster during normal hours and (iii) at the offices of Doncaster Borough Council Neighbourhood Communities and Children Services, Scarborough House, Chequer Road, Doncaster between 8.45am and 4.45pm Monday to Friday.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and proofs of evidence

Within 8 weeks of the start date 25 February 2008

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant.

Within 14 weeks of the start date 07 April 2008

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving them the Secretary of State will send copies to the Authority and the applicant (excluding copies of any supporting documents).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a copy to the Authority and everyone who has made an objection or representation (excluding copies of any supporting documents).

4 weeks before the date of the inquiry 22 April 2008

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving them, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

- i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case;
- ii) the applicant's proof of evidence to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case; and
- iii) all other proofs of evidence to the Authority and the applicant.

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case and proofs of evidence are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
