

# NOTICE OF ORDER

## WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Derbyshire County Council  
(Byway Open to All Traffic No.64 Along part of Westwick Lane- Parish of  
Walton)  
Modification Order 2005

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **25 May 2010**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a hearing.

The Hearing will be held at **Room 166a, North Block, County Hall, Matlock, Derbyshire, DE4 3AG** on **Thursday 7 October 2010** at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them the Byway Open to All Traffic No 64 in the Parish of Walton from the North side of Baslow Road at Point A (GR SK 33518 70491) proceeding in a generally east north easterly direction then turning into a generally northerly direction and finally in a north easterly direction to the southern end of Bridleway No 54 at Point B (GR SK 33852 70956) a distance of 647 metres or thereabouts.

**Timetable for sending in statements of case**

**Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 20 July 2010]**

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has made a representation.

**Within 12 weeks of the start date [by 17 August 2010]**

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Hearing must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies to the Authority, the applicant, every other person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has made a representation (excluding copies of any supporting documents).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has made a representation (excluding copies of any supporting documents).

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
